The 2003 Goldenball Shiraz from the Beechworth region in Victoria is laced with aromas of spice, red berries and preserved plums, all with good definition and an underlying elegance. The palate is supple, with fine tannins and good texture.

The quality of both the fruit and the winemaking, coupled with its tiny production, could make it quite collectable. Put down for five to 10 years.
